PCS Parent & Family Engagement Plan

Board Policy 1405 (Regulation 1405)

The Board recognizes the positive effects of parents'/families involvement in the education of their children. The Board is committed to strong parent/family involvement in working collaboratively with school's staff as knowledgeable partners in educating students. Our Parent Community Group (PCG) serves as another avenue for parents to get involved in fundraising, hosting events, and providing additional input to the school.
